

4 Days in South Korea

Location	How to get there	Notes
DAY 1		
Gyeongbokgung Palace	Ride the subway and alight at Gyeongbokgung Palace Station and walk towards Exit 5	9AM – 5PM, Closed on Tuesdays Entrance Fee: 3000KRW (approx. \$3USD)
Bukchon Hanok Village	Ride the subway and alight at Anguk Station (Subway Line 3), walk towards Exit 2.	Entrance is FREE. Don't be loud. There are people living in the houses.
N Seoul Tower	Ride the subway and alight at Myeong-dong Station, walk towards Exit 3. When you emerge from the station, turn left. You will see the Pacific Hotel. Use the road to the right of the hotel and walk uphill for 15 minutes to Namsan Cable Car Station. Take the cable car to bring you to N Seoul Tower.	Open everyday at 10AM to 11PM Cable Car Operating Hours: 10AM to 11PM Cable Car Price: 8,500KRW (Round Trip) / 6,000KRW (One Way)
DAY 2		
Nami Island	Ride the subway and alight Sangbong Station (Gyeong-Chun Line) to transfer trains; Mangu direction. After 14 stations alight at Gapyeong Station. From Gapyeong Station, we took a cab to Nami Island ferry port; 4 people on a cab cost ₩3800. (Please take note that we came from Hongik University Station. If you're coming from Seoul Station, you have to alight at Gajwa Station; after 14 stations, alight at Sangbong Station to transfer trains)	Operating Hours: 7:30AM – 9:45PM, all year round. Entrance Fee: ₩ 8,000 for foreigners, ₩ 10,000 for locals.
Cheonggyecheon Stream	Ride the subway and alight at Gwanghwamun Station, Exit 5.	No entrance fee.
Insa-dong	Ride the subway and alight at Anguk Station, Line 3, exit 6; or Jonggak Station, Line 5, exit 3.	This is one of the best places to get traditional Korean souvenirs.

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DAY 3

Dongdaemun Design Plaza	Take the subway and alight at Dongdaemun History & Culture Park Station (Seoul Subway Line 2, 4 ,5) and Exit 1.	Operating Hours: 10:00-19:00 (extended on Wed & Fri 10:00-21:00) Closed on Mondays.
Lotte Fitin / K-Live	Dongdaemun History & Culture Park Station (Seoul Subway Line 2, 4, and 5), Exit 11 or 12. K-live is located on the 9th floor and 10th floor of Lotte Fitln.	Operating Hours are weekdays : 1:30 PM ~ 9:00 PM (Closed every Monday)
Myeongdong	Take the subway and alight at Myeongdong Station and walk towards Exit 6.	Street Foods start at 4PM. If you go around makeup stores, you get freebies!
Trick Eye Museum	Take the subway and alight at Hongdae Station (Subway Line 2) and go to Exit 9, then walk straight for 200m until you see Starbucks.	Operating Hours: 9am to 9pm, open everyday.

DAY 4

Ihwa Mural Village	Take the subway and alight at Hyehwa Station (Seoul Subway Line 4), and take Exit 2. Then head towards Marronnier Park.	It's FREE to walk around and take photos. You can go there as early as you can. The earlier you're there, the easier for you to take those photo opportunities.
Bau House (바우하우스)	Take the subway and alight at Hapjeong Station (합정역) and take Exit 3. Once outside, turn around, and then make an immediate left into the alley. Then look to the right after 20 seconds. "Bauhaus" is on the first floor of "Seogyo Jeil Building".	Address: 405-13 Seogyo-dong, Mapo-gu Hours: Weekdays @ 1:30 am – 11:00 pm Weekends @ 12:30 pm – 11:00 pm
Lotte Mart	Take the subway and alight at Seoul Station and walk towards Exit 1. It is connected to the mall.	Operating Hours: 09:00–24:00 Closed Every 2nd and 4th Sunday.
